Enrolment Recommendations or Restrictions

- York University offers English as a Second language (ESL) credit courses for undergraduate students, designed to enhance students' English language proficiency, academic skills and multilingual competence. The courses count as General Education and elective degree credits, and are strongly recommended for students from an ESL background. With maximum 25 students per class, the courses support student success in their degree programs, and the transition to university study, especially in their first year at York. Please speak to your academic advisor about enrolment in these credit ESL courses.

To meet the conditions of your offer of admission for your chosen program of study, York University expects that your final results will be consistent with the mid-term/predicted grades submitted for your admission. Changes in your final results (from mid-term/predicted grades) may result in your offer being rescinded.
